1. Trust in His Power

If God can create the universe, He can handle your problems. Nothing is too difficult for Him!

Isaiah 41:10 – *“Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee.”*

2. Walk in His Presence

If God is everywhere, live in awareness of His presence. Draw near to Him daily through prayer and His Word.

3. Surrender to His Wisdom

Since God knows everything, we should submit to His perfect will.

Proverbs 3:5-6 – *“Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.”*

The greatest proof of His power, presence, and knowledge is **Jesus Christ**. He came to save sinners and

everything—past, present, and future. Nothing surprises Him, and nothing is beyond His understanding. Unlike humans, who guess and predict, God **knows** the future perfectly. He is never taken by surprise. God knows every detail of your life.

3. Surrender to His Wisdom

Since God knows everything, we should submit to His perfect will.
